### Classifications

Classifications apply to both sculling and sweep events.

Open: Open to all competitors  
Masters: Over 27  
Jr. A: Under 19  
Jr. B: Under 17  
Cox: Minimum weight for all coxies is 45 kg (honour system)

### Entry Fees

\$16 per athlete, plus the \$4 Rowing BC fee per athlete per day.

### Scratches

Scratches will be accepted without penalty until noon on Wednesday, Feb. 14th. Thereafter, the scratch fee is equal to the entry fee.
