



ROWING BC MEMBERSHIP FEE STRUCTURE FOR FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS (FPO)

FPO's wishing to become a member of Rowing BC may:

1. Pay the same \$100 membership fee that Not-For-Profit Organizations pay, plus the same \$15 fee per member participant;
or
2. Pay a higher membership fee scaled to the size of the FPO (see table below) and not pay the \$15 fee per member participant.

201 - 300	A	\$100	\$3,015 - \$4,500	\$3,115 - \$4,600
201 - 300	B	\$1,500	\$0	\$1,500
300	A	\$100	\$4,515	\$4,615
300	B	\$2,000	\$0	\$2,000

Note that FPR's do not receive the same benefits as Not-For-Profit organizations.
