Ingrid is a practicing lawyer in Vancouver (Associate, Borden Ladner Gervais LLP). Among her legal responsibilities she does policy development, regulatory analysis and contract interpretation and drafting. As a student Ingrid served as President of the Environmental Law Society at the University of Calgary.

As a past rower, she was the Captain of the University of Victoria Women's Rowing Team, and volunteer novice coach, where she advocated for the rowers, worked with the team members and coaching staff to set goals and led creative dispute resolution processes. She has competed and medalled at numerous university and club competitions, the Canada Summer Games, and the Royal Canadian Henley Regatta. She trained with the Danish U23 Women's National Team while on an academic exchange in Denmark.

Ingrid was elected to the Rowing BC Board of Directors in the position of Secretary in 2019. She is included on the Nominating Committee Endorsed Slate of Candidates for another 2 year term as a Director at Large commencing in November 2021.
