

Rowing BC Regatta Equipment

For each regatta, the “Equipment Manager” will bring/send:

A

The “**regatta set**” of equipment:

Binoculars,
Finish Flags (Large Orange, Green, Red, and White),
Finish Horn* and air canister backup,
Measuring devices (2) – intended for Control Commission,
Pocket Weather Meter (Victoria only),
Radios (Marine VHF)* with red harnesses (2) – intended for LOC Chair and First Aid,
Start Flag,
Stop-Watches, Ultrak 496 (4),
Thermometer (water), analog (Victoria only); and

For any Associates/Assistants:

Jackets, old yellow and medium blue RBC (currently Victoria only),
PFDs (2 available before cannibalizing unassigned bags.

Covid-19 risk mitigation, in the absence of an LOC supply, might require masks, gloves, and pump and spray disinfectant;

It has also been suggested that a plumb-bob and string be available for when lacking at the Finish Line;

B

1 set of each type of **spare equipment** available to be used as temporary backup/repair/replacement:

Bags and elastics (for Megaphone weather-proofing),
Batteries (16 C-cells 1.5-volt, 2 CR2032 3-volt) and tools (Jewellers Phillips screw-driver set),
Flags, Small Red,
Flags, Small White,
Radio (Marine VHF)* with red harness,
Megaphone,
Radio Accessory - HM-165 Speaker-microphone for M36,
Stop-watch, St Moritz,
Tape, electrical&/duct;

And

Unassigned Umpire Equipment Bag(s)* and Jacket(s) for any Jury members without. (As a precaution for forgetfulness/unannounced Jury changes, *consider* bringing 1 extra.)

Most (37) Licensed Umpires will have been assigned an Umpire Equipment Bag and many (?) a FarWest Gore-Tex “Whistler” Jacket. Some (16) of the least “prolific” will not. To cover off this latter group, a few (8) unassigned bags and some (?) jackets are in reserve to be brought to regattas on an as-needed and/or precautionary basis. The respective Chief Umpires *may* also express a desire to similarly equip Associates/Assistants, if supplies permit.

* Respective batteries are to be charged just prior to regattas.
