



Coastal Rowing Committee Terms of Reference

Purpose

The Coastal Rowing Committee (CRC) has been established to identify and support the needs and growth of coastal rowing opportunities across B.C. The committee will work to assess coastal rowing clubs' and individual needs, issues and concerns, and work to recognize, understand, and address these through Rowing BC.

Reporting

1. The Committee shall report through the Chairperson to the Executive Director or designated Staff Person.
2. An annual report will be created and shared within Rowing BC's Annual Report at the annual Rowing BC AGM.

Composition

The Coastal Rowing Committee shall consist of between four (4) and seven (7) who represent coastal rowing and be chaired by a Rowing BC staff member. Where possible, there will also be representation from one Rowing BC Board member.

Meetings

The CRC will meet as required and when called by the Chairperson. Meetings will be facilitated online.
